McAfee Proxy Log XML Configuration File

To configure the McAfee proxy log, we have a predefined XML configuration file to help with this process.

This document describes the steps needed to obtain the XML configuration file needed to configure the McAfee proxy log. This file facilitates the configuration process by providing the necessary coding, thus eliminating the need for you to code it yourself.

Downloading the XML Configuration file

To obtain the configuration file, complete the following steps:

- Log in to Stealthwatch's Download and License Center, https://stealth-watch.flexnetoperations.com.
- 2. On the left menu, click **Downloads** then navigate to **Upgrade Steathwatch > Upgrading Stealthwatch <version> Documentation**.
- 3. Click McAfee Proxy Documentation for Proxy Log.
- 4. Locate and click the link for the XML file for your version:
 - For McAfee proxy software versions 7.5.x and lower, use FlowCollector_ 20160322_McAfee_Log_XML_Config_v7.5.x_&_Lower.
 - For McAfee proxy software version 7.6.0 and higher, use FlowCollector_ 20170726_McAfee_Log_XML_Config_v7.6.x_&_Up.
- 5. Save the XML file to the desired location.
- 6. Follow the instructions for configuring the McAfee proxy log for the FlowCollector in the Stealthwatch Proxy Log Configuration Guide.
