Milestone	Definition	Date
<b>End-of-Life Announcement Date</b>	The date the document that announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life of a product is distributed to the general public.	May 19, 2021
<b>End-of-Sale Date: App SW</b>	The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date.	August 19, 2021
<b>Last Ship Date: App SW</b>	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	August 19, 2021
<b>End of SW Maintenance Releases Date: App SW</b>	The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software.	August 19, 2022
