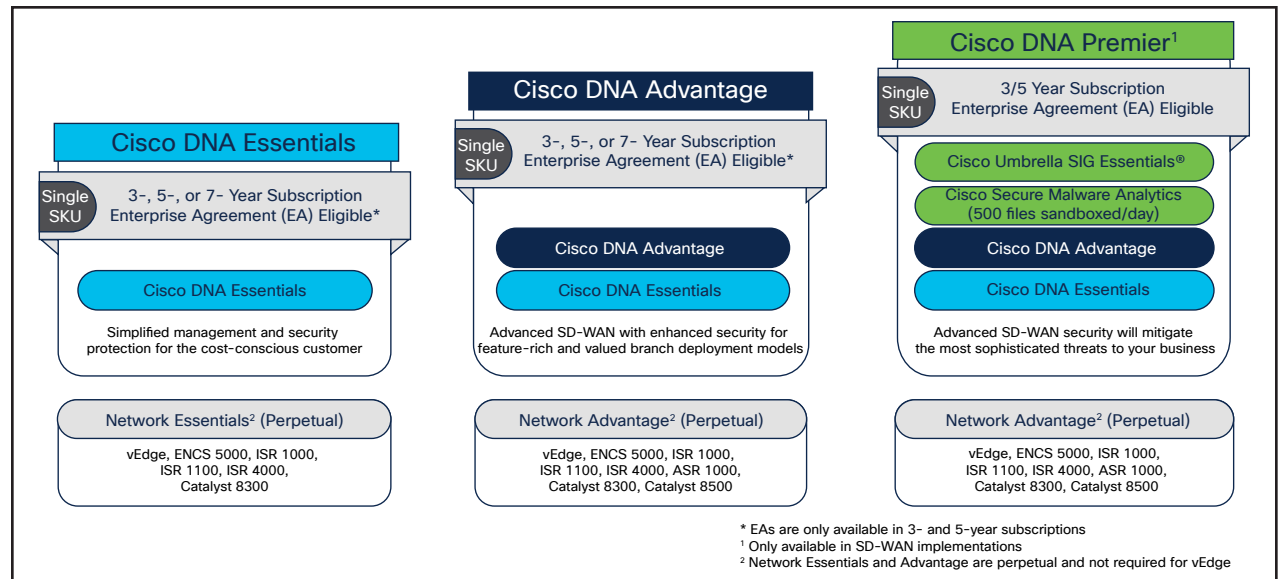


Figure 1. Cisco DNA SD-WAN and Routing software subscription offer structure

You can begin this intent-based WAN journey with Cisco DNA SD-WAN and Routing subscription offers (Figure 1).

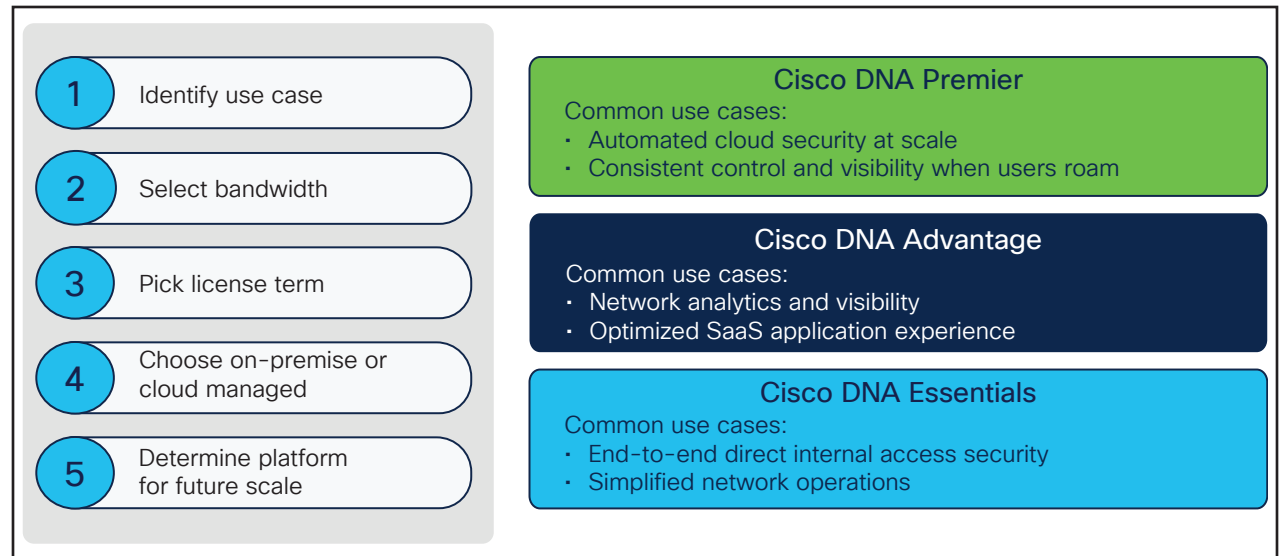


Figure 2. Selecting a Cisco DNA SD-WAN and Routing subscription

Cisco Umbrella SIG Essentials and Secure Malware Analytics entitlements in Cisco DNA Premier

With a Cisco DNA SD-WAN and Routing Premier subscription, customers receive both Cisco Umbrella SIG Essentials and Cisco Secure Malware Analytics. The license quantity entitlements listed in Table 1 below are the cumulative global entitlements across all customer sites (aggregate user count across all Cisco DNA Premier licenses purchased) for Cisco Umbrella SIG Essentials. Additional Cisco SIG Essentials user licenses can be purchased separately.

Cisco software support

However, Cisco Success Tracks is not mandatory; the customer may choose to use the Cisco Subscription Embedded Software Support included with the purchase of this software or another available Cisco support service or partner service option.

Cisco DNA for SD-WAN and Routing subscription licenses include embedded SWSS support, as well as Success Tracks and Solution Support. These services provide coverage ONLY for the subscription functionality (Cisco Catalyst SD-WAN Manager, Cisco Catalyst SD-WAN Analytics, Cisco Catalyst SD-WAN Validator, Cisco Catalyst SD-WAN Controller, Cisco Umbrella SIG Essentials, etc.) enabled by the Cisco DNA Subscription (Cisco DNA Essentials, Advantage, and Premier). These services DO NOT cover the Network Stack.

The Cisco DNA SD-WAN and Routing Premier subscription provides a Cisco Secure Malware Analytics fixed entitlement of 500 files per day per customer account to be sent to the Secure Malware Analytics cloud for sandboxing (File Behavior Analysis). This is a global entitlement across all customer sites. Additional Cisco Secure Malware Analytics licenses can be purchased separately.
