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# 1 End User License Agreement

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## 2 Cisco Unified Communications Manager IM and Presence Service End User License Addendum

This addendum ("Addendum") to the Cisco End User License Agreement ("Agreement") outlines additional Customer requirements for use of that Cisco Software licensed as part of the Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10. Customer must agree to these terms in conjunction with the Agreement acceptance in order to use the Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10 and must acquire at least one valid Cisco Unified Communication Manager user license or one valid Jabber for Everyone user license for each User accessing Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10. A "User" as used in this Addendum means either a person or another application that defines users (for example BOTs) with Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10 such as Cisco Jabber, Cisco Social Webex, a third party XMPP client, or user-based applications using Cisco APIs. Users may access Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10 concurrently so long as the User number does not exceed the number of Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10 licenses acquired by the Customer. For use of Cisco Unified Communication Manager IM and Presence Service Release 10 for federation with AOL, the customer must have purchased an AOL Federation end user license agreement for every user in the deployment.

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
